GREG VAN POPPEL, CCC

DIRECTOR OF CULINARY AND RESTAURANT OPERATIONS

Chef Greg van Poppel's career stems from a family rich in culinary tradition - both his father and grandfather were celebrated former chefs of Canadian Pacific Hotels. Completing his apprenticeship in 1997 at the Fairmont Waterfront, Chef van Poppel won the coveted Karl Shier Award for Apprentice of the Year.

Chef van Poppel worked through various progressive positions in Vancouver, including the Four Seasons Hotel, and The Fairmont Waterfront. In June 2000 Chef van Poppel competed in the Bocuse d'Or Concours Mondial de la Cuisine Canadian Qualification in Winnipeg, placing top five in the country.

Chef van Poppel was the youngest in the country to complete his Certified Chef de Cuisine designation and continued his career in establishments across Canada and abroad, including The Fairmont Dubai in the United Arab Emirates opening the iconic Spectrum on One.

Returning to his home town of Vancouver, Chef van Poppel joined the Terminal City Club as Executive Chef where he provides direction to the culinary team and 3 restaurants of the Club.

Pioneer, trendsetter, trailblazer, prospector are all words used to describe Paul Hobbs, one of the finest wine makers. His vision has resulted in exciting, structured wines that are rooted in classical old-world techniques and at the same time, are distinctly California in their expressions. Guide to California Wine named him "Wine Maker of the Year." This critically acclaimed wine maker, intrigued by the potential of other new world wines, took charge on a new project making Argentina's ongoing wine making revolution with his Cobos Malbec receiving a rating of 99 from Robert Parker of Wine Advocate Magazine. This is the highest rating ever received by a winery in Latin America.
